

DECLARATION RELATING TO THE SETTLEMENT OF REFUGEES IN GREECE AND THE CREATION FOR THIS PURPOSE OF A REFUGEES SETTLEMENT COMMISSION, SIGNED ON BEHALF OF GREAT BRITAIN, FRANCE AND ITALY. GENEVA, SEPTEMBER 29, 1923

The undersigned, representatives of the Governments of GREAT BRITAIN, FRANCE and ITALY, duly authorised by their respective Governments, hereby agree that the International Financial Commission referred to in the Protocol relating to the settlement of refugees in Greece and the creation for this purpose of a Refugees Settlement Commission, which has been approved by the Council of the League of Nations and executed on behalf of the Hellenic Government, shall discharge the duties which the said Protocol contemplates shall be performed by it; and they undertake on behalf of their respective Governments that the necessary instructions will be given by these Governments to their representatives upon the said International Financial Commission.

In witness whereof the undersigned, duly authorised for this purpose, have signed the present declaration.

Done at Geneva on the twenty-ninth day of September 1923, in a single copy which shall be deposited with the Secretariat of the League of Nations and shall be registered by it without delay.
