

**DECLARATION ON BEHALF OF FRANCE, GREAT BRITAIN AND ITALY,  
RELATING TO THE MODIFICATIONS MADE TO THE PROTOCOL OF  
SEPTEMBER 29, 1923, WITH REGARD TO THE SETTLEMENT OF  
REFUGEES IN GREECE, BY THE ADDITIONAL ACT OF SEPTEMBER 19,  
1924. GENEVA SEPTEMBER 25, 1924**

The undersigned, representatives of the Governments of France, Great Britain and Italy, duly authorised by their respective Governments, hereby undertake that the necessary instructions shall be given by the said Governments to their delegates to the International Financial Commission at Athens to take into account, in discharging the duties contemplated by the Protocol relating to the settlement of refugees in Greece and by the Statute annexed thereto, the modifications made in these instruments by the additional Act of September 19, 1924.

In witness whereof, the undersigned, duly authorised for this purpose, have signed the present Declaration.

Done at Geneva, on the twenty-fifth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, in a single copy, which shall be deposited with the Secretariat of the League of Nations and shall be registered by it without delay.
