

DECLARATION REGARDING THE PROROGATION OF THE TREATY OF FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN FRANCE AND ROUMANIA (SIGNED AT PARIS, JUNE 10TH, 1926), FOR TEN YEARS, AS FROM NOVEMBER 8TH, 1936. SIGNED AT PARIS, NOVEMBER 6TH, 1936

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC and THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF ROUMANIA, having regard to Article 9 of the Treaty signed in Paris on June 10th, 1926, agree to renew the said Treaty for ten years as from November 8th, 1936, on the understanding that the Convention referred to in Article 2, which was signed on the same day, shall remain in force for the same period.

They reserve the right to renew the Treaty of June 10th, 1926, for a further period to be fixed later, before the expiration of the period referred to above.

In faith whereof the undersigned, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed the present Agreement, which shall be communicated to the League of Nations for registration in application of Article 18 of the Covenant.

Done in Paris, in duplicate, on November 6th, 1936.
