

**RESOLUTION NO. 114 /1995 / XII.2. / OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON
THE PARTICIPATION OF A HUNGARIAN ENGINEERING CONTINGENT
OF LIMITED STRENGTH IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE FORCES
IMPLEMENTING THE PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF THE CRISIS OF THE
FORMER YUGOSLAVIA (IFOR)**

1. The Hungarian National Assembly, considering the obligations of the Republic of Hungary stemming from the United Nations Charter and the common interests of the nations living on the territory of Bosnia-Herzegovina as well as the Dayton Peace Agreement, gives its preliminary consent for the Government to send an independent Hungarian engineering sub-unit of limited strength / not more than 500 troops / in the framework of the Forces Implementing the Peaceful Resolution of the Crisis of the Former Yugoslavia / IFOR / that are to be established upon a resolution taken by the United Nations Security Council. This sub-unit should be equipped with the necessary technical means, individual (self-defensive) weapons and equipment while participating in this international peacekeeping process.

2. The assignment of the Hungarian engineering contingent will last until 31 December 1996. The Hungarian National Assembly will adopt a separate resolution on the eventual extension of the duration of the assignment.
